15 The Legislative Committee met to discuss the results of the Psychology Extender Survey as
16 published in the September 2012 final report prepared by the Division of Medical Quality
17 Assurance. There was also to be discussion regarding any general risks that might be associated
18 with pursuing legislation to address this topic.

20 Following discussion, the Committee agreed to discuss these items further with the full Board on
21 January 25, 2013 at the General Business Meeting. Ms. Clark was asked to research and report at
22 the January meeting regarding whether the Board might have authority to develop a rule on this
23 topic based on the provisions of Section 456.079(1), Florida Statutes, Disciplinary Guidelines. It
24 was mentioned that rule development might focus particularly on specifying acts that may not be
25 delegated as well as history taking requirements. Additionally, Dr. Reiff indicated that he would be
26 seeking additional information to report at the January meeting regarding the University of Florida's
27 Clinical & Health Psychology program's survey response informing that it has an online
28 psychometry certification program.
