RULES REVIEW AND/OR DEVELOPMENT

Rule 64B19-13.003, F.A.C., Continuing Psychological Education Credit

The Continuing Education Committee was tasked with updating this rule to reflect current national trends in continuing professional development for psychologists with reference to the June 2012 continuing professional development guidelines produced by the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB).

After several meetings of the Committee, the Board accepted the draft language with amendments and opened the rule for development during the April 26, 2013 General Business Meeting. Thereafter, the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC) submitted a letter providing comments on the amendments. The Board agreed during the October 25, 2013 General Business Meeting to set up a Continuing Education Committee meeting to discuss the JAPC letter.

Following discussion, the Committee provided responses on the JAPC letter. Assistant Attorney General, Rachel Clark will submit the responses to JAPC.

FPA representative, Dr. Carolyn Stimel, previous board member, Dr. Carol Webster and current board member, Dr. Harry Reiff addressed the committee during the discussion.
