13 **Tab 1.** Michael Matthews Endorsement of Other State License (PA 1991)

14 Dr. Matthews was present and was not represented by counsel.

15 Dr. Matthews applied for licensure under the Endorsement of Other State License method.  
16 Provided for the Committee's review were the application, license verification and the regulations  
17 that were in effect in Pennsylvania at the time the applicant was licensed, as well as the applicable  
18 regulations in effect in Florida during that time.

19 Following discussion, the Committee determined that the education and experience requirements  
20 in the 1991 Pennsylvania regulations were not equivalent to the Florida requirements during that  
21 same time. Due to the Committee moving toward denying the application, Dr. Matthews requested  
22 to withdraw.

23 **Tab 2.** Albert Ringewald Endorsement of Other State License (CA 1986)

24 Dr. Ringewald was present and was not represented by counsel.

25 Dr. Ringewald applied for licensure under the Endorsement of Other State License method.  
26 Provided for the Committee's review were the application, license verification and the regulations  
27 that were in effect in California at the time the applicant was licensed, as well as the applicable  
28 regulations in effect in Florida during that time.

29 Following discussion, the Committee determined that the education and experience requirements  
30 in the 1986 California regulations were not equivalent to the Florida requirements during that same  
31 time. Due to the Committee moving toward denying the application, Dr. Matthews requested to
