15 **REVIEW OF APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE**

16 **Tab 1** Rhonda Kreisman Endorsement of Other State License (CT 1985)

17 Dr. Kreisman was present and was not represented by counsel.

18 Dr. Kreisman applied for licensure under the Endorsement of Other State License method. Provided for
19 the Committee's review were the application, license verification and the regulations that were in effect in
20 Connecticut at the time the applicant was licensed, as well as the applicable regulations in effect in
21 Florida during that same time.

22 Following discussion, Dr. J. Drake Miller moved to deny the application based on the Committee's
23 determination that the education, experience and examination requirements in the 1985 Connecticut
24 regulations were not equivalent to the Florida requirements during that same time. Ms. Mary O'Brien
25 seconded the motion, which carried 3/0.

26 Following discussion, Dr. Harry Reiff moved to allow the applicant to withdraw her application. Dr. J.
27 Drake Miller seconded the motion, which carried 3/0. Dr. Kreisman chose not to withdraw her application
28 at this time.

1 **Tab 2.** David Libon Endorsement of Other State License (NJ 1990 and
2 PA1992)

3 Dr. Libon was not present, nor represented by counsel.

4 Dr. Libon has applied for licensure under the Endorsement of Other State License method. Provided for
5 the Committee's review were the application, license verification and the regulations that were in effect in
6 New Jersey and Pennsylvania at the time the applicant was licensed, as well as the applicable
7 regulations in effect in Florida during that same time.

8 Following discussion, Dr. Harry Reiff moved to deny the application under the Endorsement of the New
9 Jersey license based on the Committee's determination that the education and experience requirements
10 in the 1990 New Jersey regulations were not equivalent to the Florida requirements during that same
11 time. Ms. Mary O'Brien seconded the motion, which carried 3/0.

12 Following discussion, Dr. Harry Reiff moved to deny the application under the Endorsement of the
13 Pennsylvania license based on the Committee's determination that the education and experience
14 requirements in the 1992 Pennsylvania regulations were not equivalent to the Florida requirements during
15 that same time. Ms. Mary O'Brien seconded the motion, which carried 3/0.

16 Following discussion, Ms. Mary O'Brien moved to allow the applicant to withdraw their application within
17 14 days of the filing of the order denying the application. Dr. Harry Reiff seconded the motion, which
18 carried 3/0.

19 **Tab 3.** Frederick Nolen Endorsement of 20 Years of Licensed Psychology
20 Experience

21 Dr. Nolen was present and was not represented by counsel.

22 Dr. Nolen is before the committee due to his "yes" answer on number 30 of the application indicating that
23 his license in another state has been revoked, suspended, or in any way acted against (e.g., reprimand,
24 administrative fine, probation, etc.) Dr. Nolen was disciplined by the state of Missouri in 1991 for having a
25 dual relationship with a client.

26 Provided for the committee's review was the application, transcripts and discipline documents from
27 Missouri.

28 Following discussion, Ms. Mary O'Brien moved to approve the application. Dr. J. Drake Miller seconded
29 the motion, which carried 3/0.

30 The meeting adjourned at 9: 00 a.m.
