Tab 2. List of Applicants

Dr. Harry Reiff indicated that he assisted in providing supervision to applicant Catherine Drew; however, it would not influence his vote. Ms. Mary D. O'Brien moved to accept the list of applicants for examination and licensure as noted. Dr. Dean Aufderheide seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

Tab 8. Request for Extension/Modification: Charles Henry Madsen, Jr., Case # 2006-36570 and 2008-16914

Dr. Madsen was present and was not represented by counsel.

Dr. Madsen is before the Board for permission to complete home study courses to satisfy the requirement of the final order to take courses on boundaries.

Ms. Mary O'Brien stated she was the supervisor of the attorney who handled the case in 2006, however, that would not influence her vote.

Following discussion and the determination that the home study course may be more beneficial due to the examination at the end of the course, Dr. Dean Aufderheide moved to approve the request to complete the home study courses. Dr. J. Drake Miller seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

REVIEW OF 2014 LEGISLATION

Tab 9. SB 1212: Behavior Analysts

Dr. Reiff has requested SB 1212 go before the Board for discussion.

Following review of the bill, the Board had concerns due to the language having an impact on Chapter 490 F.S. due to behavior analysis being in the Scope of Practice for Psychology. Dr. Harry Reiff requested that this item be added to the April 25, 2014 General Business Meeting agenda for further discussion.

FPA representative, Ms. Connie Galietti, JD, Executive Director, addressed the Board indicating FPA's opposition of the bill.

Following discussion, Dr. Harry Reiff moved that the Board is in opposition of the bill. Dr. J. Drake Miller seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

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Tab 10. CS/CS/HB 7015: Military and Veteran Support

Dr. Reiff has requested CS/CS/HB 7015 go before the Board for discussion.

The Board discussed the bill; however, due to it already being passed, no formal motion was made.

Tab 11. SPB 7028: Telemedicine and SB 1646: Telemedicine

Dr. Reiff has requested SPB 7028 go before the Board for discussion.

Following discussion, the Board requested this item to go before the Legislative Committee during the April 25, 2014 General Business Meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Tab 12. Granting Continuing Education Credit for Prescribing Psychologist Register Courses.

Prescribing Psychologist Register has been a Board approved provider since May 31, 2002. They have recently come into compliance with reporting requirements in CE Broker, however, it has been reported by CE Broker, and acknowledged by Prescribing Psychologist Register, that there are 22 licensees who may have taken its advertised medical errors course, which did not have specific Board approval. Licensees may have also taken non-APA home study courses it advertised, which would normally not be eligible for renewal credit. Prescribing Psychologist Register has notified the individual licenses and offered a course of action to remedy the issue.

This item is for the Board's review and determination as to whether they will allow credit under Rule 64B19-13.007(2), F.A.C., Licensees may have assumed approval of courses since Prescribing Psychologist Register is a Board approved provider.

Dr. Luis Orta and Dr. Dean Aufderheide recused themselves due to both taking the course from Prescribing Psychologist Register.

Following discussion, the Board made no formal motion. The individuals who have taken the course may file a petition for variance or waiver, if necessary.
